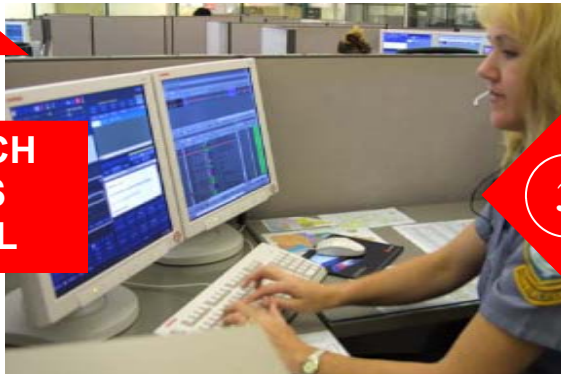

Hand signals are designed for silent pleas for **HELP**.

ALERT and HELP HAND SIGNALS

With eye contact to a person looking directly at you make the signals below.



First hold the ALERT signal for a silent count of 1-2

Second hold the HELP signal for a count of 1-2.

Third hold the ALERT signal for a count of 1-2.

Fourth hold the HELP signal for a count of 1-2.

Fifth hold the ALERT signal for a count of 1-2.

Sixth hold the HELP signal for a count of 1-2.



Continue making the signal to observers that look at you.

Observers will call 9-1-1 that a child or adult is giving the PAAAS SIGNALS, stay on the line to give additional information.

This is a special self survival program for victims of constant abuse of life threatening situations, for those without access to a cell phone.

Sound signals are designed for an audio aid for those out of sight pleading for **HELP.**

ALERT AND HELP SOUND SIGNALS



Blast Vehicle Horn

1. Give blasts with a vehicle horn for a count of 1-2.
2. Pause for a count of 1-2 then repeat the horn blast for a count of 1-2.

Repeat the above segment three times, then pause for a minute or two then repeat the two steps in the above segment

Observers will call 9-1-1 reporting that someone is giving the PAAAS help sound signal with the address.

Light signals are designed for a visual aid to those in the darkness pleading for **HELP**.
ALERT AND HELP LIGHT SIGNALS



**Be Vigilante For Flashing Lights
in Buildings**



**Watch for Vehicle Flashing Headlights,
Interior and Stop Lights.**

To give the help light signal from a house, turn on any visible light facing a street or give the flash of a vehicle head light, brake lights or interior lights, in the same time intervals and segments as the sound signals 1-2 on 1-2 off repeat three times and then pause for a minute or two and repeat the segment.

This is an easy to learn but a silent way to tell your community that you need emergency **HELP**.

The light system is designed to aid self survival during the darkness.

Observers will call 9-1-1 reporting someone is giving the PAAAS help light signals with the address.

FOR THE FASTEST PHONE EMERGENCY HELP NATIONALLY CALL 9-1-1

Nine-one-one is only to be used in emergency situations. An emergency is any situation that requires immediate assistance from the police/sheriff department or the fire department or an ambulance. If you are ever in doubt you should call 9-1-1. It's better to be safe and let the 9-1-1 call taker get you emergency help. Anytime, anywhere, and from any device.

Do not call 9-1-1:

- for information
- for directory assistance
- when you're bored and just want to talk
- for paying traffic tickets
- for your pet
- as a prank

If you call 9-1-1 by mistake, do not hang up. Tell the call taker what happened so they know there really isn't an emergency.

How do I make a 9-1-1 call?

- In an emergency, dial 9-1-1 on your phone. It's a free call. You can use any kind of phone: push button, rotary, cellular, cordless, or pay phone. (With some pay phones, you may need a coins to get a dial tone; with wireless phones, Enhanced 9-1-1 does not yet work.)
- Stay calm and state your emergency
- Speak loudly and clearly. Give the 9-1-1 call taker your name, phone number and address where help is needed.
- Answer the call taker's questions. Stay on the telephone if it's safe to do so, and don't hang up until the call taker tells you.

Make Life Safer

The procedure was developed by the space agency NASA



The data from  to the closest  sends data to the closest 911  that receives the location in longitude and latitude. In seconds the dispatcher calls the cell phone, if no answer the first responder patrol will respond to the address.

How to program a cell phone

Cell phones differ in there programming, for best information call your cell phone provider.

For this system to activate a cell phone must be speed dial to 911 and it is recommended the five button/key be programmed to send the data out, for in an emergence when a cell phone is found the five key should be pressed to alert authorizes of the location of the person that summon for HELP

The data bypasses the 911 operator, and in seconds the HELP plea is at the dispatcher

Where the dispatcher will call the cell phone that requested the HELP asking what is needed, if no answer a first respond patrol will arrive at the reported location address

**Exactly to the longitude and latitude of the plea was send for HELP, in a metropolitan area to a building or in a rural area for and auto accident or a jogger or anyone with there life threatened
